PLAY SNOW

For your classroom

Invite the children to explore the "snow" with their hands, noticing its cold, soft, and squishy texture. As they touch and mold the play snow, encourage them to describe the feeling using words like "fluffy," "smooth," or "cool." You can provide small shovels, plastic cups, or toy snowmen for children to build their own mini snow creations or pretend to make snowballs.



What you'll need:

- 1 cup conditioner (make sure it is white to reflect "snow")
- 1 cup baking soda or cornstarch
- Mixing bowl
- Sensory bin



- Letters or Numbers to hide in the "snow"
- Glitter (optional)

What to do:

- Mix equal parts conditioner and baking soda (or cornstarch)
- Add glitter (optional)

**Please note: You double or triple the recipe to make as much as you need for your students.
