

CLASSROOM JOBS



Classroom jobs for preschoolers can help promote a sense of responsibility, teamwork, and independence. These jobs are simple and age-appropriate, giving children a chance to contribute to the classroom environment. Here are some ideas:

I. Line Leader

• The child who is the line leader gets to guide the class in and out of the room, leading the group to the next activity.

2. Door Holder

• This child helps hold the door open for others when entering or leaving the room.

3. Paper Passer



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• Responsible for passing out papers, worksheets, or materials to classmates.

4. Helper of the Day
